Every year, approximately 1,500 families stay at the Ronald McDonald House of Indiana while their children receive life-saving treatment at Indianapolis-area hospitals.

The House at Riley has six overnight guest rooms for families whose children are being treated in one of the Riley Critical Care Units: the ICU North, the ICU South, the Newborn ICU, the Infant ICU, the Burn Unit, and the Stem Cell Transplant Unit. The most important feature is that families are just steps away from their critically ill or injured children. FCI donated this room in appreciation of Dr. David Hertz and the NICU staff at the Community North Hospital of Indianapolis.
